Eugene Airport milestone

PROP SPINNERS: The Eugene Prop Spinners and Eugene Airport have reached a milestone. This year marks the 40th anniversary of model airplane flying as a part of the airport milieu. They began flying at the airport in the winter of 1967-68, first using an open grass area near the terminal and a part of the tarmac. In about 1970, the flying site outside what is now the airport Administration office was developed, with an asphalt circle, four grass circles, fences and bleachers. In the mid-1980s, the Prop Spinners participated in the design of the overflow parking lot, and that has been the flying site since. The contest held on Memorial Day Weekend was the 37th annual, and all but about eight of them have been held at the Eugene Airport. The airports support of various aviation groups has always been a big part of our commitment to community organizations.
