Also, please include in your report the hometown of the contestants, and note which contestants are juniors. Only Northwest residents are counted in the standings (AMA Dist. XI and British Columbia). The score of each contestant also should be listed for general reporting purposes and for checking against the Northwest records, another popular FL feature.

Remember, only results that we receive can be counted, so send them in. If you flew in a contest that doesn't appear to be counted, contact the contest director or FL and let us know.





The second contest of the season had 10 entries on a rare good weather day. There were 2 new novice flyers, Mike Chies, a junior, and Jeff Riechel, from Everett. The other entries were Adrian Duncan, Rick Meadows, Bruce Matthews, David Pelletier (a junior and the last contest winner), Remy Dawson, Angelo Chies, Paul Dranfield. and Mel Lyne.

Just about everyone was getting good motor runs, with Paul and Mel doing a fair bit of pitting. Some of the new flyers were really going for it, and this resulted in several modeldestroying mid-airs. A bit more practice and control needed there. But most matches had four minutes or more of good combat.

At the end of 5 rounds, Angelo, Paul, and Mel were on top, with Mike the top novice. Steady flying and keeping the model in the air had again determined the finalists.

The first semi had Mike against Paul. Paul took it pretty casual, and Mike got up a cut. Paul came down for a better motor setting, and then was up hammering around, and got back 2 cuts. But it wasn't enough, and Mike won on air time.

The second semi had Angelo against Mel. This was an all-out effort with Angelo really hammering, and Mel trying to line up a cut. It finished with Mel getting the only cut, and narrowly emerging the victor.

The final had novice Mike Chies against Mel. Mike managed an early cut, but Mel was too sly for him, and finished taking the match with 3 cuts. A pretty good effort from Mike in his first ever contest, taking 2nd place.

Our last contests champ, Dave Pelletier, was having an off day, and lost 2 models in mid-airs, but finished with a good effort flying a battle-worn Yeti.




