Chris Sarnowski and Brian Stas were in close pursuit with one loss apiece. In round three Chris got the bye while Neil was earning a two cuts to one win over Brian. This left only Chris and Neil to battle it out with Chris having to win twice which he did earning the contest win in the process.



You made it a very enjoyable contest.







