Why Does Easter Fall On A Different Date Each Year?

Easter and other religious holidays related to it—Ash Wednesday, Palm Sunday, and Good Friday—are called "moveable feasts." This means that they are not fixed dates on the calendar. Instead, these holidays are assigned according to what's called a lunisolar calendar, which aligns the moon's phases as well as the sun's position in the sky. (Passover and other Jewish holidays also adhere to the lunisolar calendar.)

WHAT'S NEW AND UPCOMING

Dave Leavens elaborated on upcoming Club activities this year. Please refer to the Newsletter for details of events and activities.

President Dave passed out Gold Club pins to the membership. New member Patrick Schmid was introduced.

The following donations were approved: \$100 to the AMA to support participation in the 2024 Scale **World Championship in Romania**, \$200 to St. Mary's church for use of their gymnasium for winter meetings, \$200 to the Mt. Hope/Funks Grove park district for use of their community building for Friday night in-door flying.

The second of two votes to change the By Laws to include a Club Webmaster passed with no opposition. John Cralley will serve as the first official Club Webmaster.

The March meeting is the final meeting at St. Mary's for the spring. The April meeting will be held at 2:00 pm at the field weather permitting. Larry' shed is alternate site.

Larry read the minutes from the February meeting. Minutes were approved as read.

Dennis gave the treasurer's report. With income of \$700 and expenses of \$635.31 the ending balance for February was \$30,923.55. The report was approved as given.

No VP update was available.

OLD BUSINESS

Larry presented the drawings for the addition to the shed. Work will begin April 1 at 8:00 AM, weather permitting and entail emptying the shed and removing the metal siding. Steve Meyer encouraged members to participate. Further details, such as tools needed, will be forthcoming via email.

Larry mentioned that modification to add weight to the field roller has been completed, with the assistance of Steve Meyer and a nice welding job by Rob Houchin. This will save the club \$500-\$600 annually for the cost of a rental. Cost was \$117.



NEW BUSINESS

Bob Statsholt passed around the mowing schedule for this year and encouraged members to sign up for mowing.

Dave Leavens had contacted the Normal Parks & Rec department to investigate the possibility of SIRS being added to their web site/events calendar. Normal P&R Dept is in the process of revising their events calendar so this is tabled.

For <u>Show & Tell</u>, Jerry displayed a ½-A Hawker Hurricane control line fighter powered by a Cox 049. Jerry elaborated on growing up with these types of models and stressed participation in the upcoming <u>Vintage Model Aviation Day</u>, which will feature both R/C and C/L. Members are encouraged to resurrect planes from their youth for either static display or for flying and join the fun on July 8 and 9. Entrance fee will be \$10 each day and include a lunch.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned on a motion by Jerry and a second by Jim. Indoor flying resumed after the meeting.
