The old Meeting Minutes Sentral Illinois Radio Society February 11. 2023

After an hour of in-door flying in the St. Mary's gym, President Dave Reed called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm with 11 members present. In attendance were Dave Reed, Larry Kupferschmid, Randy Doss, Dave and Sherrie Leavens, Dewayne Leavens, Justin Worden, Jerry Worden, Steve Meyer, Tony Cellini, Bob Statsholt.

WHAT'S NEW AND UPCOMING

The first of two votes to change the By Laws to include a Club Web Master passed with no opposition. If the second vote at the March Club meeting passes, John Cralley will serve as the first official Club Web Master. This will not be an executive position.

Dave Leavens elaborated on upcoming Club activities this year. Please refer to the Newsletter for details of events and activities.

Larry read the minutes from the January 14 meeting. Minutes were approved as read. President Dave gave the treasurer's report in Dennis's absence. With expenses of \$105.02 and no income, the ending balance for January was \$30,858.86. The report was approved as given. No VP update was available.

OLD BUSINESS

President Dave reported that SIRS as reached Gold Club status with the AMA.

Larry reported that the Field Improvement Committee (aka Building Committee) submitted a proposal to the Executive Committee to add a 12 ft x 24 ft extension with a concrete floor on the east side of the existing shed. The Executive Committee approved the project with the understanding that the proposal would be shared with the members at the February meeting. With no objections from the members at the February meeting, the project will proceed as spring weather permits. Cost will be around \$16,000.

NEW BUSINESS

Larry proposed, and will pursue, modifying our field roller to add weight saving \$500-\$600 annually for the cost of a rental. Cost to be around \$100.

It was decided to contact FS Lawn Services for a one-time application of pre-emergent with fertilizer to control the crab grass and fox tail, which are spreading throughout the field. Cost will be \$900.

President Dave will contact the Normal Parks & Rec department to investigate the possibility of SIRS being added to their web site/events calendar.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned on a motion by Jerry and a second by Tony. Indoor flying resumed after the meeting.




