will be available from 6:00 pm to 9:00 pm on Fridays barring any scheduling conflicts. Larry read the minutes from the November 12 meeting. Minutes were approved as read. Dennis gave the treasurer's report. With expenses of \$799.06 and no income, the ending balance for November was \$31,318.41. The report was approved as given. After soliciting and considering ideas for field improvement from the membership, the Field Improvement Committee reported that they are costing out an addition to the existing shed. The plan that is being considered is a 12' x 24' addition to the east side of the shed, using similar construction. The addition would increase pavilion space to relieve congestion at events and meetings with the addition of work benches for repairs; the picnic supply storage would be cleaned up; and additional space for the lawn equipment would be created. The entire building would have a concrete floor. A rough cost estimate is that the expansion can be completed for under \$20,000 if members contribute the majority of the labor involved. Club membership will be updated at future meetings as things progress, and will be presented a final plan for approval. The Field Improvement Committee is comprised of Larry Kupferschmid, Dennis Garrigus, Bob Stadsholt, Justin Worden, Dave Leavens, Steve Meyer and Randy Doss. Dick Hanson is advising on design and construction.

#### **NEW BUSINESS**

Speaker of the month was Ed Collins, giving us vital information on LiPo batteries. Kris will present 3D printing as the January Speaker.

Dave R polled the membership on length of meetings. It was decided to conduct meetings with a 1-hr limit.

Next meeting: January 14, 2023, at St Mary's. Indoor flying 6:00 pm. Meeting 7:00 pm. There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned on a motion by Kris and a second by Jerry. Indoor flying resumed after the meeting.




