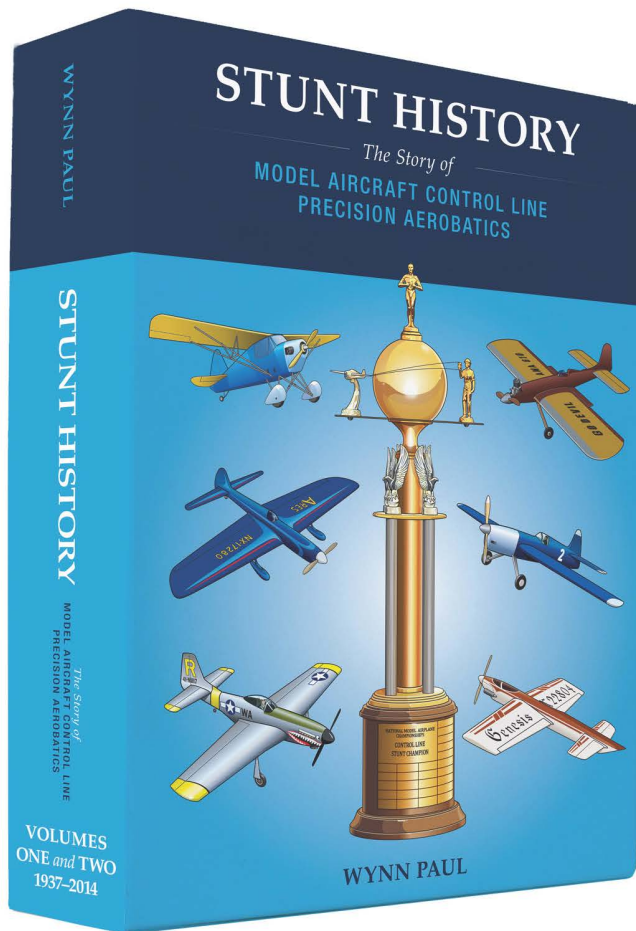


# STUNT HISTORY

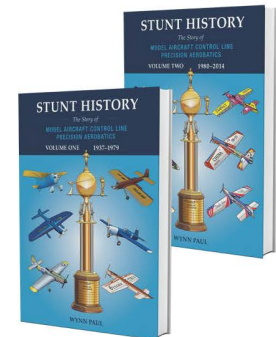
